Moving and storing one of the world's most vital resources

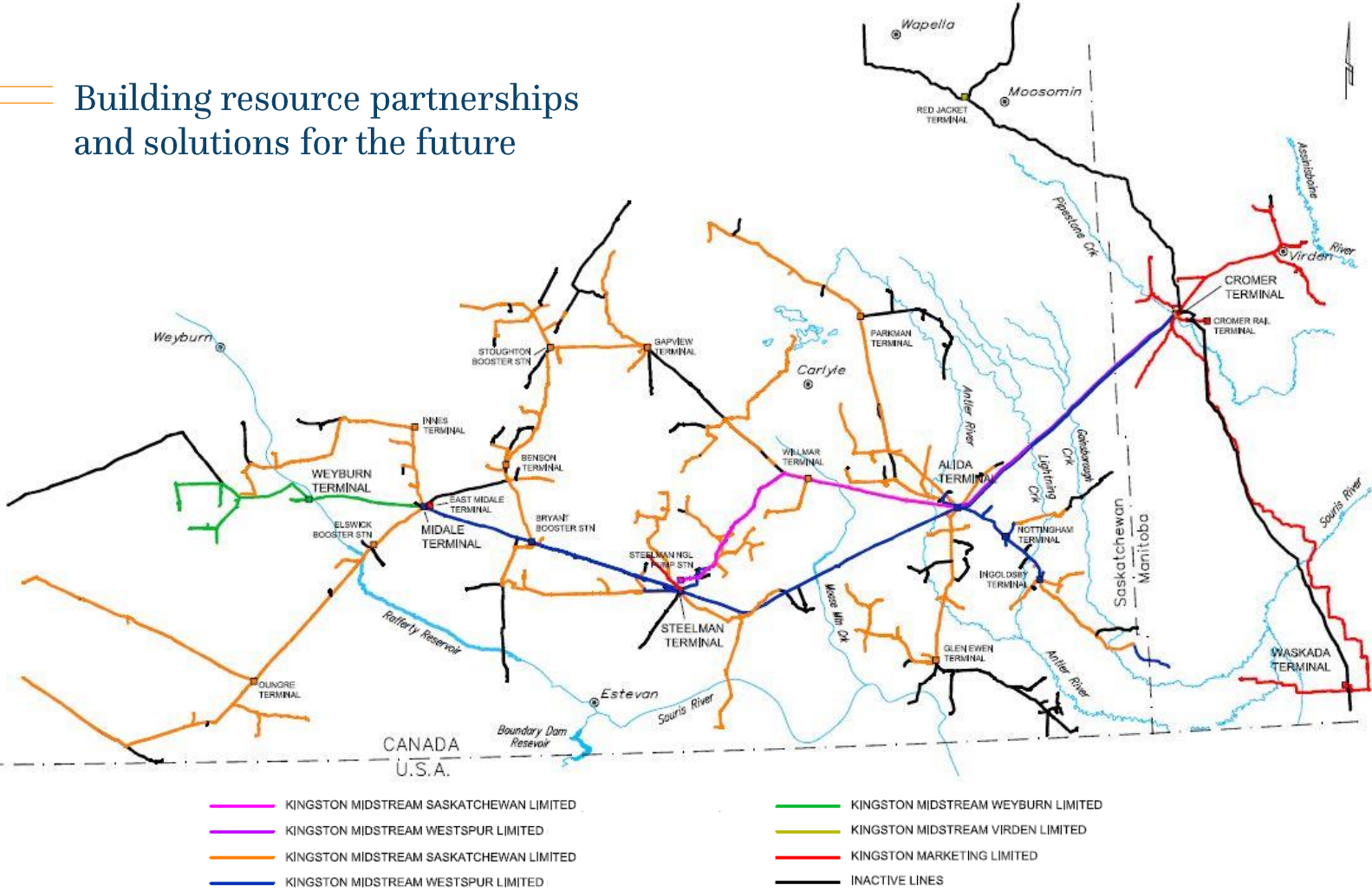
Our System

Kingston Midstream's system consists of gathering networks within southeast Saskatchewan and southwest Manitoba. These networks flow into our Westspur Pipeline, which ultimately connects to the Enbridge mainline.

We also own and operate several storage facilities along the pipeline system. These facilities are used to safely store crude oil before transportation to refineries and other market destinations.
